

#### ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Bholanath College, Dhubri, is one of the premier Institutions of Higher Learning in Western Assam. It was with the initiative of LATE ZAHIRUL HOQUE, the then district magistrate (Deputy Commissioner) of the erstwhile Goalpara District accompanied by the pioneering and untiring efforts of some dedicated and learned personalities of Dhubri, specially Dr. Phani Bhushan Roy (founder Principal of the college), Mr. R.K. Bose,

Mr. S.K. Bose, Rai Bahadur A.K. Ghosh, Rai Bahadur B.M. Dutta, Mvi Jahanuddin Ahmed (MLA), Mr. Mukunda Narayan Barua, Mvi Ghyasuddin Ahmed (MLA) backed by the financial assistance of ZAMINDER FAMILY of the Lakhipur estate that the college came to be formally inaugurated on the 16th August, 1946. Formerly it was affiliated to the Calcutta University. Later on it became one of the affiliated colleges of Gauhati University after its establishment in 1948.

The college which started functioning from the present office of the Deputy Inspector of Schools, Dhubri, was shifted to its present campus at Ward No. 15 of Dhubri Town in 1960-61. B.N. College introduced P.G. Diploma Course in Computer Application (PGDCA) in regular mode under Gauhati University from 2016.

#### xi) OPEN & DISTANCE LEARNING SYSTEM:

a) The college has been offering post graduate courses since 2006 through its Study Centre of 'Institute of Distance and Open Learning' (IDOL) under Gauhati University. Besides various diploma courses, the centre offeres Post Graduate Courses in Assamese, English, Economics, History, Political Science, Philosophy, Education, Mathematics, Commerce and Journalism & Mass Communication. Contact classes are held at regular interval and examinations of all the above courses are held at B.N. College as per the rules and regulations of IDOL, Gauhati University.

b) A study centre of K.K. Handiqui State Open University has been set up in the college in the year 2008. The study centre offers various courses starting from Bachelor Preparatory Programme (B.P.P) to P.G. Courses.

N.B. The details of the courses are available in the prospectus of the respective center.


## **Community Outreach programme**

As a part of its Social responsibility, the college, has been rendering services and carrying out different activities. The college has organized Science Exhibition at Tiamari Girls M.E. School. The college has also constructed a girls' toilet at this school. The college carried out plantation programme, village survey and other awareness programme at the village Raipara (Jhagrarpar Pt-iv).

The college has been conducting classes at different schools of Dhubri District with the help of the faculty members of this college under the Assam Govt. Organic Linkage Scheme since the academic session 2016-17. As a part of the Organic Linkage Scheme students from different schools visit the college. The teachers of the college guide the students and make them familiar with the facilities available at the central library and different laboratories of the college.

# C. Admission Procedure

## How to Apply?

Application forms for admission to the college is attached with the prospectus. The form Completed in all respects is to be submitted to the office of the Principal in time. Incomplete application forms in any respect will be rejected. Students applying simultaneously for all the streams must use separate application forms.

#### D. Admission procedure 👅

Students seeking admission shall have to present themselves before the admission committee as per dates & time to be notified by the College Authority.

No application shall be considered valid unless it is accompanied by the self attested copies of mark sheets, certificates, photograph, original gap certificate (where required), etc. as mentioned in the application form. Moreover, the candidates will have to produce the original copies of the same at the time of admission. Admission into various classes will be done as per merit list prepared by admission committee of the college. The admission schedule will be notified in due time.



#### E. Reservation of seats

There is a provision for reservation of seats for students belonging to SC, ST (P), ST(H). OBC, MOBC and differently abled categories and sports quota as per Govt. Rules. The candidates of reserved categories shall have to produce valid certificates issued by the competent authority.

#### F. Rules & Regulations



# Students remaining absent for consecutive 15 days in major classes will forfeit their seat in major course.

# Attendance of students in classes, Laboratory works and tutorial classes are compulsory. Students attending individual classes up to 75% or above in the H.S. (both 1st yr 2nd yr) classes are allowed to appear at the A.H.S.E.C. Examination while students attending individual classes in semester courses up to 75% or above are allowed to appear as regular candidates at the University Examinations. For private and casual students (with specific subjects) specific University regulations will be applicable. Students' class attendance will be calculated every month. Students failing to attend 75% of the total lectures delivered will be treated as non-collegiate and such students have to pay Non-Collegiate fee as per G.U. rules. The students having class attendance less than 60% will be treated as discollegiate and such students will be debarred from appearing at sessional and end semester examinations.

# G. Teaching and Evaluation

The college follows the ACADEMIC CALENDAR of G.U. for under graduate and of A.H.S.E.C. for H.S. course and is subject to G.U. and A.H.S.E.C. course regulations respectively. Besides, the college has got its own Academic Calendar showing. total no of working days, teaching days and dates and times for various Internal Examinations. The College has its own mechanism to evaluate the performances of the students for continuous evaluation and thereby maintaining quality education. The college has shown excellent results all along.

In addition to normal class room teaching, the college imparts teaching by organizing Seminars, departmental Seminars, tutorial classes etc. The evaluation process is continuous and based on the students progress in class assignments, Unit Test, Laboratory works (for science stream), field works and Examinations.



## H. Discipline

# **BHOLANATH COLLEGE**

The student admitted to the college must abide by the rules and regulations of the college. Violation of the rules, irregular attendance, irregular payment of College and Hostel dues and fees, showing discourtesy to the teacher and employees in any form, ragging, adopting of unfair means in the examination and loitering are strictly prohibited. Causing damage to the College properties, smoking, taking alcoholic beverages and intoxicating drugs within the campus or in the public place are some of the offences which may make a student liable for disciplinary action, viz., forced transfer, termination of scholarship and even expulsion from the College and Hostel.

## I. Admission fees, Tuition fees, and other dues



The selected candidates will have to pay admission fees, tuition fees and other dues at the time of admission as fixed by the Govt. of Assam.

### J. Students Support services



- ★ Digital Classroom: The college has Modern Digital Classroom facility.
- ★ Hostel Accommodation : At present the college has a Girls' Hostel having a capacity for 80 students with adequate facilities. There are two Boys' Hostel having 50 Seats with adequate facilities in the College Campus.
- ★ Library : The college central library is well-equipped with computer system (automation), Internet Connectivity and a Reading Room, e-resources, Reference Section catering to the needs of teacher, Students and Employees of the College. Its total collection of reading materials including Text Books, Reference sources, general books and a few sets of Encyclopaedias is more than 46,500. There is a Digital Library as a wing of the Central Library, a soft copy corner with e-book. Besides National and International e-journals are available with N-list facility in the library.

The Central Library has book bank facilities for the students belonging to ST/SC and other backward communities.

- iv) Ishan Uday Scholarship from UGC only for Degree students.
- \* Biotech Hub : Biotech Hub funded by Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India was established in 2012 for promoting higher research. Students of this college and from the nearby schools get an exposure of research in Biotechnology, Microbiology and Molecular biology etc.
- \* Educational Excursion: The students of the college are generally encouraged to participate in educational excursion. For the students of Botany & Zoology of T.D.C. (Sc) classes, departmental educational excursion is made compulsory by G.U. Besides, an Environmental excursion is compulsory for all degree 4th semester and H.S. 1st Year students of Arts, Science and Commerce and Computer Application courses.



★ Extra and Co-curricular Activities : Necessary facilities for N.C.C., N.S.S., Scout & Guide and facilities for games and sports such as football, volleyball, cricket, badminton etc. are provided in the college. The students are also offered facilities for participation in local, regional and national events. Modern Basketball, Volleyball court and Badminton court are available for students.

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- ★ B.N. College Cricket Academy: The college has established B.N. College Cricket Academy under the active guidence of Mr. Javed Zaman, an alumnus of the college and ex. member of Indian A cricket team and now working as NCA level B Coach. This academy aims to train up the students of the college and of the local youths as well as to impart knowledge and skill of cricket.
- ★ Career & Counselling Cell: This cell provides career guidance to the students by distinguished experts and organises classes on current affairs and general knowledge.
- ★ Grievances and Redress cell: The college has a Grievances and Redress cell to address the grievances of students and staff.
- ★ Students Aid Fund: There is a 'Student Aid Fund' in the College to provide financial assistance to students coming from economically weaker section of the society.
- ★ Health Unit: The College has a 'Health Unit' within its campus. One health attendant was appointed for the same.
- ★ Yoga Centre & Gymnasium Centre: The College has 'Yoga Centre' and 'Gymnasium Centre' within the campus to create health awareness among its employees (Teaching & Non-teaching), students and outsiders.
- ★ UGC Network Resource Centre: An UGC Network Resource Centre was established in the college in 2010. The centre is equipped with 20 computers. Internet facility is available in the centre.

N.B.: College Uniform is compulsory for all students within the college campus. The students must attend classes in College Uniform.

Bio-Technology - 5000/- (per semester)


