## **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

Bhola Nath College, Dhubri, is one of the premier Institutions of Higher Learning in Western Assam. It was with the initiative of LATE ZAHIRUL HOQUE, the then district magistrate (Deputy Commissioner) of the erstwhile Goalpara District accompanied by the pioneering and untiring efforts of some dedicated and learned personalities of Dhubri, specially Dr. Phani Bhushan Roy (founder Principal of the college), Mr. R.K. Bose, Mr. S.K. Bose, Rai Bahadur A.K. Ghosh, Rai Bahadur B.M. Dutta, Mr. Jahanuddin Ahmed (MLA), Mr. Mukunda Narayan Barua, Mr. Ghyasuddin Ahmed (MLA) backed by the financial assistance of ZAMINDER FAMILY of the Lakhipur estate that the college came to be formally inaugurated on the 16th August, 1946. Formerly it was affiliated to the Calcutta University. Later on it became one of the affiliated colleges of Gauhati University after its establishment in 1948.

The college which started functioning from the present office of the Deputy Inspector of Schools, Dhubri, was shifted to its present campus at Ward No. 15 of Dhubri Town in 1960-61. The present campus is spread over a little more than 50 Bighas of land. The campus is beautifully interspersed with gardens and different plants. All in all the present campus offers a great scenic view.

The college has infrastructural facilities for all departments with well equipped library and internet connectivity.





## COURSES OF STUDY

The College at present is functioning in two shifts- Day & Special for Degree Courses only and Day shift for Higher Secondary Courses.

Two year Higher Secondary courses in Arts & Science.

Three Year Degree Courses (Consisting of SIX semesters) in Arts & Science and Bachelor of Computer Application (B.C.A) / B.Voc (IT)

### A. Subjects offered in H.S. Courses

#### I) ARTS STREAM

##### Compulsory Subjects :

English, MIL (Assamese, Bengali, Hindi) / Alt. English.

##### Elective Subjects :

Economics, Political Science, History, Mathematics, Logic & Philosophy, Sanskrit, Arabic, Advance Assamese, Advance Bengali, Advance Hindi and Education.

##### Subject Bar :

A student can offer either Mathematics or History, Classic or Advance Language.

#### II) SCIENCE STREAM

##### Compulsory Subjects :

English, MIL (Assamese, Bengali, Hindi) / Alt. English.

##### Elective Subjects :

Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, And Statistics.



A student is required to take 3 or 4 Elective subjects besides compulsory subjects, English & MIL. Environmental Education is compulsory for H.S. First Year Classes (Arts/Science).



**B. Three Year Degree (spread across six semesters) in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) **

#### iv) Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA)

BCA is a Three-year Degree Course consisting of 6 semesters.

**Eligibility :** The candidate must have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination from Science / Arts / Commerce. Students who have passed the Higher Secondary examination with either Mathematics or Computer Science as one of the subjects obtaining minimum pass mark in the subject will be given preference. Students completing Diploma in CSE / IT from AICTE recognised institutes are also eligible for taking admission.

**(Sponsored by the Govt. of Assam)**

From the academic session 2017-18, the college has introduced the Bachelor in Vocational course (IT). As per Govt. Instruction, the number of seats in this course is fixed at twenty only.

**vii) P.G. Course in ASSAMESE :** ↓

The College offers P.G. Course in Assamese under Gauhati University. The course duration is two years consisting of four semesters. Seat capacity is limited.

**viii) P.G. Course in CHEMISTRY :** ↓

The College offers P.G. Course in Chemistry under Gauhati University. The course duration is two years consisting four semesters. Seat capacity is limited.

**ix) P.G. Diploma Course in COMPUTER APPLICATION (PGDCA) :** ↓

The College offers P.G. Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA) in regular mode under Gauhati University.

**x) OPEN & DISTANCE LEARNING SYSTEM:** ↓

The College has been offering Post Graduate Course since 2006 through its Study Centre of "Institute of Distance and Open Learning" (IDOL) under Gauhati University. Besides various diploma courses, the centre offers Post Graduate Courses in Assamese, English, Economics, History, Political Science, Mathematics, Commerce, Philosophy and Journalism & Mass Communication. Contact classes are held at regular interval and examinations of all the above courses are held at B. N. college as per the rules and regulations of IDOL, Gauhati university.

### C. Admission Procedure (How to Apply)



1. Students seeking admission for Degree 1st semester and HS 1st year classes can apply online by clicking the tab "Online Admission Form" available on the home page of [www.bncollege.org.in](http://www.bncollege.org.in). Students applying simultaneously for different streams must apply separately.
2. Admission for Degree 2nd year (3rd and 4th semester), 3rd year (5th and 6th semester) and HS 2nd year classes will be on offline mode. Students can take admission by collecting the admission form from the office of the Principal, B. N. College, Dhubri by paying Rs. 300/- (Three hundred) only through ATM/Credit Card.





### D. Admission Procedure

Students seeking admission shall have to present themselves before the admission committee as per dates & time to be notified by the College Authority along with the printed copy of the Application form submitted on-line and self attested copies of mark-sheets, certificates, photograph, original gap certificate (where required), caste certificate etc. as mentioned in the application form. Moreover, the candidates will have to produce the original copies of the same at the time of admission. Admission into various classes will be done as per merit list prepared by admission committee of the college and the same will be uploaded in the B.N. College website. The admission schedule will be notified in due time.

### E. Reservation of Seats

There is a provision for reservation of Seats for students belonging to SC, ST(P), ST(H), OBC, MOBC and differently abled categories and Sports Quota as per Govt. Rules. The candidates of reserved categories shall have to produce valid certificate issued by the competent authority.

### F. Rules & Regulations

# Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college campus.

# Students remaining absent for consecutive 15 days in major classes will forfeit their seat in major course.

Attendance of students in Classes, Laboratory works and Tutorial Classes are compulsory. Students attending individual classes up to 75% or above in the H. S. (both 1st year & 2nd year) classes are allowed to appear at the A.H.S.E.C. Examination while students attending individual classes in semester course up to 75% or above are allowed to appear as regular candidates at the University Examinations. For private and casual students (with specific subjects) specific University regulations will be applicable. Students' class attendance will be calculated every month. Students failing to attend 75% of the total lectures delivered will be treated as non-collegiate and such students have to pay Non-Collegiate fee as per G.U. rules. The students having class attendance less than 60% will be treated as discollegiate and such students will be debarred from appearing at sessional and end semester examinations.

### G. Teaching and Evaluation

The College follows the ACADEMIC CALENDAR of G.U. for under graduate and of A.H.S.E.C. for H. S. Course and is subject to G.U. and A.H.S.E.C. course regulations respectively. Besides, the college has got its own Academic Calendar showing total no. of working days, teaching days and dates and time for various Internal Examinations. The College has its own mechanism to evaluate the performance of the students for continuous evaluation through Diagnostic test and Mid term test and thereby maintaining quality education. The College has shown excellent results all along.

In addition to normal class room teaching, the college imparts teaching by organizing Seminars, departmental Seminars, tutorial classes etc. The evaluation process is continuous and based on the students progress in class, home assignments, Unit Test, Laboratory works (for Science Stream), field works and Examinations.

### H. Discipline

The student admitted to the College must abide by the rules and regulations of the College. Violation of the rules, irregular attendance, irregular payment of College and Hostel dues and fees, showing discourtesy to the teacher and employees in any form, ragging, adopting of unfair means in the examination and loitering are strictly prohibited. Causing damage to the College properties, smoking, taking alcoholic beverages and intoxicating drugs within the campus or in the public place are some of the offences which may make a student liable for disciplinary action, viz., forced transfer, termination of scholarship and even expulsion from the College and Hostel.





**I. Admission fees, Tuition fees and other dues** ↓

The selected candidates will have to pay admission fees, tuition fees and other dues at the time of admission as fixed by the Govt. of Assam.

**J. Students Support Services** ↓

- + **Digital Classroom:** The College has Modern Digital Classroom facility.
- + **Hostel Accommodation:** At present the College has a Girls' Hostel having a capacity for 80 students with adequate facilities. There are two Boys' Hostel having 50 Seats with adequate facilities in the College Campus.
- + **Library:** The College Central Library is well-equipped with computer system (automation), Internet Connectivity and a Reading Room, e-resources, Reference Section catering to the needs of teacher, students and employees of the College. Its total collection of reading materials including Text Books, Reference sources, general books and a few sets of Encyclopaedias is more than 47,250. There is a Digital Library as a wing of the Central Library, a soft copy corner with e-book. Besides National and International e-books, e-journals are available with N-list (INFLIBNET) facility in the library.

The Central Library has Book Bank facilities for the students belonging to ST/SC and other backward communities.

- + **Biotech Hub:** Biotech Hub funded by Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India was established in 2012 for promoting higher research. Students of this College and from the nearby schools get an exposure of research in Biotechnology, Microbiology and Molecular biology etc.

- + **B. N. College Cricket Academy :** The College has established 'B. N. College Cricket Academy' under the active guidance of Mr. Javed Zaman, an alumnus of the college and ex. Member of Indian A cricket team and now working as NCA level B Coach. This academy aims to train up the students of the college and of the local youths as well as to impart knowledge and skill of cricket.

- + **Career Counselling and placement Cell :** This cell provides 'Career Guidance' to the students by distinguished experts and organizes classes on current affairs and general knowledge.

- + **Grievances and Redressal Cell:** The College has a 'Grievances and Redressal Cell' to address the grievances of students and staff.

- + **Yoga Centre and Gymnasium Centre:** The College has 'Yoga and Gymnasium Centre' within the campus to create health awareness among its employees (Teaching & Non-teaching), Students and outsiders.

- + **UGC Network Resource Centre:** A 'UGC Network Resource Centre' was established in the College in 2010. The centre is equipped with 20 computers. Internet facility is available in the centre.

- + **Health Centre:** The College has a 'Health Centre' in the campus, which is managed by the college authority.

- + **Scholarship:** The following Scholarship are available for students studying in the College.

- i. State Merit Scholarship
- ii. National Merit Scholarship
- iii. Scholarship for the students belonging to backward Communities and Minority Communities.
- iv. Ishan Uday Scholarship from UGC only for Degree students.

- + **Students Aid Fund:** There is a 'Student Aid Fund' in the College to provide financial assistance to students coming from economically weaker section of the society.

- + **Educational Excursion:** The students of the College are generally encouraged to participate in educational excursion. For the students of Botany & Zoology of T.D.C. (Science) classes, departmental educational excursion is made compulsory by G.U. Besides, an Environmental Excursion is compulsory for all degree 4th semester and H. S. 1st year students of Arts, Science and Computer Application courses.

- + **Extra and Co-curricular Activities:** Necessary facilities for N.C.C., N.S.S., Scout & Guide and facilities for games and sports such as football, volleyball, cricket, badminton etc. are provided in the College. The students are also offered facilities for participation in local, regional and national events. Modern Basketball, Volleyball court and Badminton court are available for students.
