### 5. A Brief Write-up of the Programme:

A Competition on Sanskrit Conversation (Samskrita Sambhasana Pratiyogita) was organised by the Department of Sanskrit, B. N. College for the students of Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre, B. N. College, on 20.02.2021 at 2 pm in Digital Classroom of the College. Dr. Dhruba Chakrabortty, Principal, B. N. College, presided over the occasion. Sri Abdul Motleb Mondal, Vice Principal of the College and Dr. Susmita Sengupta, Coordinator, IQAC, B. N. College were also present on the dais to dignify the occasion. Altogether 65 number persons including both the teachers and students attended the programme. Dr. Mausumi Bhattacharjee, H.O.D. of Sanskrit, B. N. College explained the purpose of the competition and welcomed everyone. Sri Indrajit Simha, Teacher of Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre, appointed by Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi and Dr. Mausumi Bhattacharjee, H.O.D. of Sanskrit acted as the judges of the competition. Altogether 10 number of students divided into 5 groups took part in the competition and presented the conversations through dramatic performances. Priyanka Bhattacharjee and Nupur Saha of B. A. Ist Semester Honours class won the **Ist prize**. Aparupa Pal, a student of English Department and Susmita Roy, a student of Education Department became the winner of 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize and Kakoli Karmakar of H.S. Ist year and Violena Deka, a student of B. A. 5<sup>th</sup> Semester class became the winner of 3<sup>rd</sup> prize. All the students who took part in the competition were given a certificate of proficiency.

To give the students a preliminary idea of Sanskrit conversation skill and thereby to popularise Sanskrit culture was the **main objective** of organising the programme. After the declaration of

the result, Dr. Mausumi Bhattacharjee offered vote of thanks on behalf of Sanskrit department and the programme ended there.
