

**REPORT OF INAUGURATION OF NON-FORMAL SANSKRIT EDUCATION
CENTRE, SPONSORED BY CENTRAL SANSKRIT UNIVERSITY, NEW DELHI**

1. Name of the Programme: Inauguration of **Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre**, sponsored by **Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi**.

5. A Brief Write-up of the Programme:

The inaugural meeting of Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre, B. N. College, sponsored by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan (a Deemed University), New Delhi was held on 17.09.2019 at 3-15 pm in the Digital Class room under the chairmanship of Dr. Dhruva Chakraborty, Principal, B. N. College, Dhubri. Dr. Upendrajit Sarma, Associate Professor, Deptt. of Assamese graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Altogether 81 no.s of persons were present in the occasion. This Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre has been functioning in the college since 2016. This certificate course consists of two levels of studies- *Prathama Diksha* and *Dvitiya Diksha*. For performing classes of this session (2019-2020), Sri Indrajit Singha has been appointed as the teacher of this centre by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi. At present there are 54 students in *Prathama Diksha* and 33 students have been admitted in *Dvitiya Diksha*. As a part of its Sanskrit popularisation programme, this Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre, in collaboration with Sanskrit Department, has taken part in an Extension Activity in Bidyapara Boys' Higher Secondary School. At present 15 no. students of 9th and 10th standard of this school has been enrolled in the centre. As per the permission of the Principal of the school, Sri Indrajit Singha has been taking a class for these fifteen students, who have been admitted in *Prathama Diksha*.
