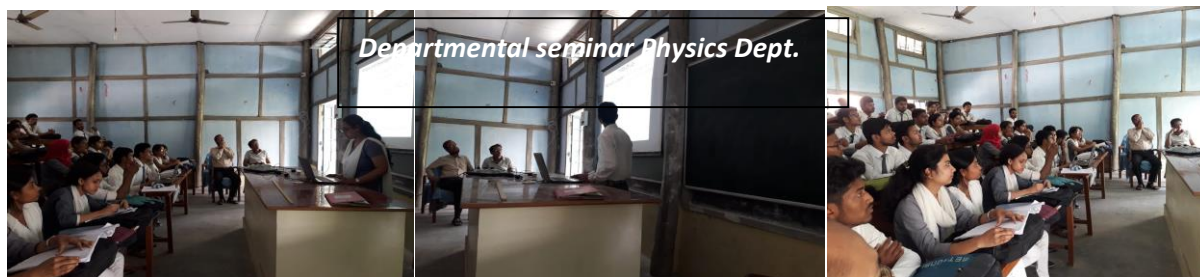

As a best practice of last session “The departmental seminar of Physics department” is emerged as an integrated part of department of Physics B.N. College Dhubri. The main aim of the departmental seminar is to uplift the level of slow learner by discussing the important topics of their syllabus under supervision of respective teacher who taught that topic in the class. Each participating group of the seminar contain five/six members, and during the formation of groups care has been taken that the group members should represent the all categories namely slow, medium and advanced learner. The time period of each seminar was fixed 30.00 minutes and followed by 10.00 minutes discussion. The entire departmental seminar was organised in the Physics Gallery of the department.

For the odd semester i.e. from June 2018, the total numbers of departmental seminars that was organised for six days selecting the Wednesday and Friday of the week (excluding the holiday) at time 3.15 PM. Each participating group for this semester contain five members. The seminar was started on 21/09/2018 and was ended on 10/10/2018 with six numbers in a participating group from 1st, 3rd and 5th semester, respectively.



On the other hand for the even semester i.e. December 2018, the total numbers of departmental seminars that was organised for five days selecting Friday of the week (excluding the holiday) at time 3.15 PM. The seminar was started on 08/03/2019 and was ended on 26/04/2019 with a numbers of five participating groups from 2nd and 4th semester, respectively. Each group contain six members. For this semester the sixth semester students are exempted for the departmental seminar as they have compulsory seminar.

In the programme, as a whole 28 numbers of presentations have been delivered by 150 students of the department and all the teachers and major students were present in the seminar as audience.
