5. A Brief Write-up of the Programme:

A Field-visit was undertaken by the Deptt. of Sanskrit, B. N. College, Dhubri on **15.12.2020** in Bidyapara Boys' Higher Secondary School, Dhubri for popularising Sanskrit language and Sanskrit culture. For that purpose, an awareness programme entitled '**Jayatu Samskritam**' was organised by the Department of Sanskrit, B. N. College, Dhubri in collaboration with Non-formal-Sanskrit Education Centre, B. N. College, sponsored by Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi. This Programme on '**Jayatu Samskritam**' was started on 22.08.2019 and this year also an awareness Programme was undertaken as a follow-up Extension activity and in this connection a meeting was organised under the chairmanship of Sri Jayanta Kumar Dey, Principal, Bidyapara Boys' Higher Secondary School, Dhubri at 10-30 am. Altogether 15 No. of students of Sanskrit Department and Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre, led by Dr. Mausumi Bhattacharjee, H.O.D. of Sanskrit, Dr. Chandra Shekhar Upadhyaya, Asstt. Prof., Deptt. of Sanskrit and Sri Indrajit Singha, teacher of Non-formal Sanskrit Education Centre, B. N. College attended the programme. Total 63 No.s of persons (students and a few teachers of the school including the Teaching Faculties of B. N. College) were present in the meeting. The main focus of the programme was to create awareness among the students about the importance of Sanskrit language as well as Sanskrit culture.
