

5. A brief write-up of the programme:

The Eco Club of B.N. College, Dhubri observed World Environment Day on 5th June, 2022. Students and faculties of various department participated in the event enthusiastically. The programme was inaugurated by the Principal, Dr Dhruba Chakraborty with his inaugural speech. The event was also graced by the Chairman of Dhubri Municipal Board, Dr. Debamoy Sanyal. In connection with the observation of the World Environment Day, the day long programmes were organised in the college campus:-

- **Awareness Meeting:** An awareness speech was delivered by the Coordinator of the Eco Club, Dr. Puranjoy Mipun. The Coordinator urge the students to remain conscious and connected with the Nature. He advice the students that the protection of environment is not only for the professionalism but this much be perform by each and every one of us as a true devotion to the mother Nature.



- **Sowing the Seeds of Indigenous Plants:** Sowing of seeds of 50 local indigenous plant varieties namely Mango, Litchi, Bokul, Jackfruit, etc. were done by the teachers, students and NCC volunteers of the college.



- **Tree Plantation:** A total of 15 indigenous tree species namely *Terminalia arjuna* (Arjun- 5 nos), *Cassia javanica* (Radhasura- 5 nos.) and *Monoon longifolium* (Debdaru- 5 nos.), were planted in different places of the college campus.



- **Orchid Plantation:** An initiative was taken to conserve the wild orchid species (15 nos.) donated by The Orchid Society of Eastern Himalaya (TOSEHIM) by allowing them to grow suitably on the trees of the college campus. In this programme teachers and students actively participated.



- **Drama on Environmental Awareness:** A drama ‘*Lorar kirili*’ (written by Dr. Aloka Sharma Asso. Prof., Department of Assamese, B.N. College, Dhubri) was staged by the members of Drama Club of the college to create awareness and a sense of responsibility


for conservation of biodiversity. Through their drama they highlighted our role to save every single species of the nature.
