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
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ICT and Higher Education

Information and communications technology (ICT) is an extensional term for information technology (IT) that extends the role of unified communications. It refers to the convergence of audio-visual and telephone networks with computer networks through a single cabling or link system. ICT is an umbrella term that includes any communication device, encompassing radio, television, cell phones, computer and network hardware, satellite systems and so on, as well as the various services and appliances with them such as video conferencing and distance learning.

Now-a-days ICT has become an integral part of teaching learning process. Effective use of technology can motivate students, make our classes more dynamic and interesting and renew teacher enthusiasm as they learn new skills and techniques.

The role of ICT in higher education is becoming more and more important and this importance will continue to grow and develop in 21st century. The use of ICT in education not only improves classroom teaching learning process, but also provides the facility of e-learning. The adoption and use of ICTs in education have a positive impact in teaching, learning and research. The use of ICT will not only enhance learning environment but also prepare next generation for future lives and careers.

India has taken up major initiatives in terms of content delivery and furthering education through ICT. For instance Gyan Darshan was launched in 2000 to broadcast educational programs for school kids, university students, and adults. Similarly Gyan Vani was another such important step which broadcast programs contributed by institutions such as IGNOU and IITs. Under the UGC country wide classroom initiative, education programs are broadcast on Gyan Darshan and Doordarshan's National Channel (DD1) everyday. E-Gyankosh which aims at preserving digital learning resources is a knowledge repository launched by IGNOU in 2005. Almost 95% of IGNOU's printed material has been digitalized and uploaded on the repository. The National Programme for Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) launched in 2001 is another joint initiative of IITs and IISc which promotes education through technology. Moreover, the ambitious National Mission on Education through ICT was launched by the government to harness ICT's potential throughout the length and breadth of the country. In 2009, the government approved the landmark "National Mission on Education through ICT" scheme. The National Mission on Education through ICT is centrally sponsored scheme submitted by the Ministry of HRD and approved by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA). The Mission has planned a variety of initiatives aimed at developing and standardizing digital content for Indian higher education segment.

The role of ICT in the higher education sector needs to assess the problems and prospects in its implementation. Literature on ICT in education continues to project that it can help improve India's higher education system by providing greater equity, better access and improved quality. There is a growing apprehension that ICT can transform India towards becoming a knowledge society. The majority of Indians living in rural areas have poor access to internet, which requires exposure and training in basic computing skills and ICT utilization. Moreover, the low awareness on IT literacy is also a major challenge India faces in realizing ICT implementation in higher education. The Internet and Mobile Association of India (IAMAI) reported that a majority of government institutions do not have sufficient IT systems. ICT has no doubt brought about tremendous change in education that requires to achieve the desired level of IT adoption in higher education in the country. The optimal utilization of opportunities arising due to diffusion of ICTs in higher education system presents enormous challenge. Nonetheless, it has become an indispensable support system for higher education as it could address some of the challenges facing higher education system in the country. Moreover, it can provide access to education regardless of time and geographical barriers. Similarly wider availability of course material in education which can be shared by means of ICT, can foster better teaching learning process.

Educational Philosophy of Swami Vivekananda

Swami Vivekananda is one of the greatest social reformers and educationist of all time. Vivekananda's educational philosophy is deeply rooted in traditional Indian Philosophy, specially in Vedanta. He describes the true nature of man as Soul-Force or Atman. To realize the divine perfection is the goal of true education. He says, "Education is the divine perfection already within man."

Vivekananda believes that real education is neither book learning nor diverse knowledge. He considers real education is that which enables one to stand on one's own feet. "Education must provide life-building, man-making, character-making assimilation of ideas" The ultimate aim of all education, all training, according to Swamiji is man-making.

Swamiji believed that in order to make education useful, it must be according to the nature and need of the child. He says "Everyone develops according to his own nature. When the time comes everyone will come to know this truth. Do you think you can educate a child? The child will educate himself; your job is to provide the necessary opportunity to him and remove the obstacles in his path." Thus, Vivekananda advocates the principle of self-education.

Vivekananda was against the British system of education in India which ignored the fundamental aspirations of our nation. Therefore, he advocated the introduction of a national system of education based on Indian educational heritage and national ideals. He advocated for the national system of education in order to make the minimum education available to all and to introduce essentials of Indian culture in each and every child of the country.

Vivekananda has great appreciation for the "Gurugriha Vasa". He insisted upon chastity and personal contact of a good teacher as essential for good education. He said that the teachers are playing more significant roles in shaping the destiny of the nation. Teachers should have very high character and should be sinless, because a perfect man alone is a true transmitter. He said that duty of a teacher ends, when he instils ideas, morality and hope for improvement in the minds of the students.

Swamiji stressed the comprehensive nature of education. It should aim at character -building, physical -education, cultivation of arts, study of humanities with special reference to Indian culture and technological training. He advocated mother-tongue as the medium of instruction and appreciated the greatness of Sanskrit also. He said that besides the knowledge of own mother tongue people should have the knowledge of Sanskrit. Without Sanskrit, it will be impossible to understand Indian culture.

Vivekananda laid stress on mass education which implies adult education and free and compulsory education regardless of caste, creed or colour. According to him without mass education the desirable socio-economic changes in our country is not possible. Vivekananda said, "The education which does not help the common mass of people to equip themselves for the struggle for life, which does not bring strength of character, a spirit of philanthropy, and the courage of a lion-is it worth the name?" He was a strong supporter of women education. He considered education of women as the chief instrument of national regeneration. Swamiji revolutionized almost the entire field of education. He inspired the millions of Indian youths by his revolutionary ideas of education. As an educationist he believes in absolute values which have to be realized by a good system of education. The teachings of Vivekananda are of great importance in the reorganization of our present systems of education.


Several private institutes have also adopted the model of BN College, including the Happy Convent School, where the students access the classes on the mobile phones of their guardians.
